Dear Parents

At 8:15 pm tonight the Premier announced a 4 day lockdown for the Perth and Peel region commencing at midnight tonight. This follows a further case of community spread reported this evening.

CEWA have advised that -

- Schools will remain open
- Parents may choose to keep their children at home, as with the previous lockdowns
- Requirements for mask wearing remain unchanged

If you are choosing to keep your children at home please advise the school office by email at admin@padcath.wa.edu.au

As we are experiencing a lockdown in the wider community and as many of the exposure sites are in our school's vicinity we are implementing some additional measures –

- All non-essential meetings will be cancelled. Families who have a meeting arranged to meet with any staff should call the school office to clarify whether the meeting will go ahead
- All after school activities will be cancelled
- Parents on any roster will need to reschedule for next term
- If you decide to send your children to school, we ask that you use the kiss and ride facilities both on O'Leary Road (please do not park there in the morning) and in the top carpark this week. There will be staff members at both locations in the mornings to assist your child out of your car and, if your children are in PK-PP, a staff member will assist them to their classroom.
- At the end of the day PK, K, PP children are to be collected through the top Kiss and Ride in the carpark (so please do not park there in the afternoons) at 2.45pm. Siblings will be waiting with PK, K, PP children. Once again staff members will be supervising and assisting children into cars.
- Only staff will be permitted to enter classrooms.

This is an evolving situation and I have been advised by CEWA that a full briefing will be provided to Principals in the morning. I will then be able to provide further information to you.

I thank you for your understanding and co-operation during this lockdown period and appreciate your continued support.
